19		Commissioner Berndt updated Commissioners on the 12/14 City Council meeting related
20		to the Short-Term Rental ordinance. Commissioner Berndt suggested Commissioner
21		should tune in to the Council meetings to preview what the City Council is working on.
22		There should not be a conflict or accidental quorum of Commissioners. The meetings are
23		also live streamed on Facebook and the City website and streamed on Inland television.
24		Commissioner Berndt stated that the Council took no action and asked to review the code
25		again in January. Commissioner Berndt suggested that he needed to review the code
26		history and provide what he learns to the City Council.
27		Staff asked whether existing, unlicensed short-term rentals become nonconforming and
28		would they be counted as part of the 250-ft consideration. Also, whether the
29		nonconforming lots would need to be cataloged.
30		Staff updated the Commission on 2020 Planning Department work and grants used and
31		submitted in 2020.
32		Commissioner Berndt also updated the Commission on the topic of the transfer of the 12-
33	5.	acres from Suncadia to the City.

39		agreed and added there are County funds that may potentially be available to use in
