  - a. Upon assumption of current planning responsibilities by the Hearing Examiner, the Planning Commission should be able establish a monthly meeting schedule.
  - b. If it is determined that the Planning Commission must conduct the public hearing and make a recommendation on the proposed Major Modification to the Bullfrog Flats Master Site Plan and Development Agreement, this work program will need to be revised.
- If there are any applications submitted by March 31 requesting an amendment to the Comprehensive Plan through the annual docketing process, this work plan will need to be revised.

  - a. The proposed amendments to update the City's Shoreline Master Program requires DOE approval and may take more time than the process to update the City's Critical Area regulations.
