Community Task Force

The city seeks applicants interested in participating in a task force for the ADA Self Evaluation and Program Access Plan and Safety Action Plan project. The group will meet periodically throughout the duration of the project, which is scheduled to run through April 2026. The community task force will be responsible for:

1. Reviewing inventory data and making a recommendation on a prioritized project list.
2. Identifying goals and policies to ensure long-term implementation of the plan and monitoring.
3. Assist in the development of a public engagement plan to ensure that all interested members of the public can participate.
4. Provides general oversight while the ADA Self Evaluation and Program Access Plan and Safety Action Plan are developed.

The Transportation Task Force will demonstrate a balanced commitment to the adopted project scope of work and represent a broad spectrum of interests, including but not limited to, the following:
